# About FYI

Fresh Youth Initiatives (FYI) exists to help children and teens in Washington Heights/Inwood become leaders in our community. You may not even realize that you “know” us! You may have walked by our headquarters on 171<sup>st</sup> Street between Amsterdam and Audubon Avenues; you may have seen, or even benefited from, the results of our participants’ contributions to the neighborhood. FYI youth beautify the community when they paint colorful outdoor murals, clean parks, plant gardens, and erase graffiti. In the winter, they serve food to people in need, distribute hand-sewn sleeping bags to the homeless, and operate NYC’s only youth-run food pantry which distributes more than 300 grocery packages per month to families in need.

## FYI’s Summer Camp

Most importantly, the safety of our campers is our top priority and we take all precautions to ensure a safe environment.

FYI’s youth philosophy weaves together community service projects, leadership development skills, enrichment activities and exciting trips around the city into a fun and rewarding summer experience.

## Our Staff

- Our program staff are all First Aid-RTE and CPR certified.
- Certified lifeguards accompany all water trips, in addition to staff and counselors.

- Current immunization record required with application.
- Copy of summer homework packet.
